TWO PRIMARY AREAS THAT PROMPT OUR ACTION

MATERIAL POVERTY

This is when families don't have enough money or resources for basic needs like food, housing, clothing, healthcare, & education. For children, this can cause developmental delays, emotional stress, & fewer opportunities for a better future.

RELATIONAL POVERTY

In this situation, families lack strong, supportive relationships with family, friends, or their community. As a result, they may experience loneliness and isolation, without the emotional or practical support they need - especially during times of crisis.

111PROJECT & CAREPORTAL: WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE?

Think of 111Project as the “who” behind the “what”. We manage CarePortal for the state of Oklahoma. CarePortal, like any technology, can't be a movement without a driving local organization. The CarePortal platform only works if there are people making requests and responding to them. Over the last 10 years, 111Project has built a network of care that works daily to see resources come to families instead of families having to find resources. Our network provides support during times of crisis while also helping families achieve case plan goals through partnerships with trusted professional agencies.

111Project exists to see that every child in Oklahoma has family. CarePortal allows everyone to do something, making it one of our primary tools for collaboration and collective impact.

HOW WE USE CAREPORTAL IN OKLAHOMA

Every request is an opportunity for connection that addresses both barriers of **MATERIAL** poverty and **RELATIONAL** poverty. Needs are evaluated and requested by someone who knows the family.





3. GROW GIVING

The federal government shutdown in November caused a temporary pause in our funding, resulting in an unexpected revenue shortfall of more than \$100,000 for 111Project in 2025.
