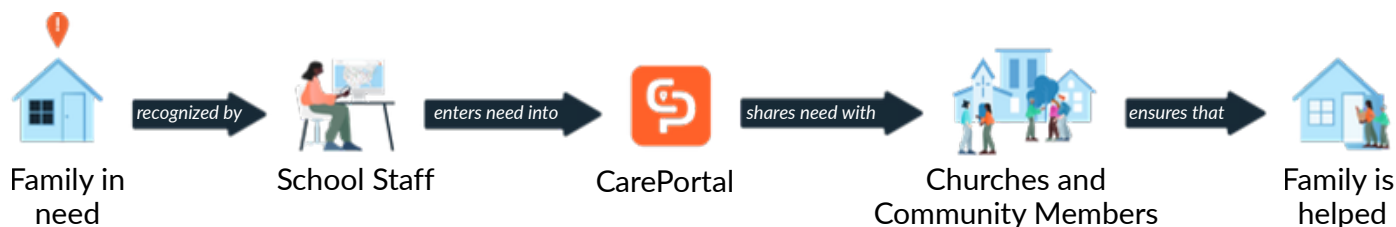


Children thrive in families, and families thrive in community.

- Reduce strain on school and agency resources
- Keep children safe and supported in their homes

Through partnership with OKDHS, CarePortal has no cost for schools to use—removing barriers, so we can serve more families together.



What is 111Project?

111Project is a non-profit based in Oklahoma that mobilizes local churches and communities to support vulnerable children and families. 111Project manages the CarePortal platform for Oklahoma.

What is CarePortal?

CarePortal is a technology platform that helps schools connect students and families in need with local churches and community partners who can help.

When a school identifies a need—like a bed, clothing, or other need—it's entered into CarePortal. The request is shared with nearby churches and community members who can respond, providing direct, tangible support.

Schools can use CarePortal to facilitate broad participation in drives for in-kind donations that benefit their students. Schools can also use CarePortal to advocate for volunteer needs such as mentoring and tutoring.
